Position: Livelihoods Project Officer

Location: Zahedan, Iran (with travel to areas within Iran where RI operates when

requested by supervisor)

Duration: One year with possible extension (3 months' probation)

Reports to: Head of Office/Livelihoods Advisor

About RI: Relief International is a leading nonprofit organization working in 20 countries

to relieve poverty, ensure well-being and advance dignity. We specialize in fragile settings, responding to natural disasters, humanitarian crises and chronic

poverty.

Relief International combines humanitarian and development approaches to provide immediate services while laying the groundwork for long-term impact. Our signature approach -which we call the RI Way- emphasizes local participation, integration of services, strategic partnerships, and a focus on civic skills. In this way, we empower communities to find, design and implement the

solutions that work best for them.

RI in Iran: Relief International has been active in Iran since 1989. The Iran operation

focuses on providing and improving access to health, education and livelihoods to Afghan refugees — with protection effectively mainstreamed across our activities. Relief International is a major actor in disaster response in Iran and currently implements a large scale COVID-19 response. We support national CSOs as well as coordination and advocacy with other INGOs, UN agencies and Governmental partners to improve the overall humanitarian and development

response.

Position Summary: The Livelihoods Project Officer will work on the livelihoods project

implementation and will be supervised by and will directly report to the Head of Office. S/he will be working closely and constructively with the country livelihood team on technical issues. She/he will be responsible to provide support to the livelihood team and ensure that project objectives are on track

and project impact is ensured.

Position Responsibilities and Duties:



- Implement the livelihood projects/initiatives properly to achieve the key results as planned;
- Conduct livelihoods assessments including market analysis, socioeconomic assessments, institutional mappings, etc.;
- Assess current livelihoods programs and develop improvement plans;
- Build and maintain strategic partnerships with key stakeholders including private sector, financial service providers, development actors, government etc.
- Be involved in community mobilization, sensitizing the target groups on project outputs and deliverables and facilitating the training for the project's partners and youth/women's groups
- Coordinate and facilitate assessments, planning, budgeting, coordination, implementation, and monitoring and evaluation relevant to livelihoods projects
- Draft, review and provide technical feedback on livelihoods reports and proposals
- Working closely with the country livelihood team to ensure that the project, finance, and donor reports are prepared in a timely manner
- Ensure that, lesson learnt through monitoring and evaluation are captured, capitalized and incorporated into future proposal designs
- Ensure that technical and administrative support is provided to the project implementation activities
- Contribute to the Afghan refugees' skills identification and livelihoods needs assessment analysis
- Ensure that data from the field is correctly filled in and shared in the right formats, including inputting to the RI database
- Support the development of capacity building plans for the project's target groups
- Attend the project mobilization and livelihood team meetings
- Work closely with the country livelihood team to ensure and track the progress of the project activities, their outcomes and impact
- Travel and be present in project locations to ensure and support successful project performance and implementation
- Work closely with the M&E team to ensure input of relevant and accurate data into donor reports, into the correct donor formats
- Participate in needs assessments as and when directed by the livelihood country team and/or the Head of Office:
- Carry out all other duties as assigned by the supervisor.

Qualifications & requirements:

- University degree in Development Studies, Economy or Socio-Economic Development, Business Administration, or another related field
- Minimum 5 years of relevant (international) job experience with graduate degree (equivalent of a Master's), 6 years with undergraduate degree (equivalent of a BA/BS).
- Experience with advocating, mobilizing and with working with multiple stakeholders, including
 private sector, development agencies, government authorities, NGOs and social enterprises, in subsectors relevant to livelihood engagement e.g. microfinance, employment, entrepreneurship,
 private sector development, local economic development, micro-finance, poverty reduction,
 agriculture, livestock, vocational and technical education and training, etc.



- Exhibits interest in having two-way communication; demonstrates openness in sharing information and keeping people informed
- Works collaboratively with colleagues to achieve organizational goals; solicits input by genuinely valuing others' ideas and expertise
- Willing to learn from others; places team agenda before personal agenda; supports and acts in accordance with final group decision, even when such decisions may not entirely reflect own position; shares credit for team accomplishments and accepts joint responsibility for team shortcomings
- International experience is an asset
- Fluency in both Farsi and English writing and speaking is essential; Dari desirable
- Microsoft Word, Excel, Outlook skills essential; Access desirable
